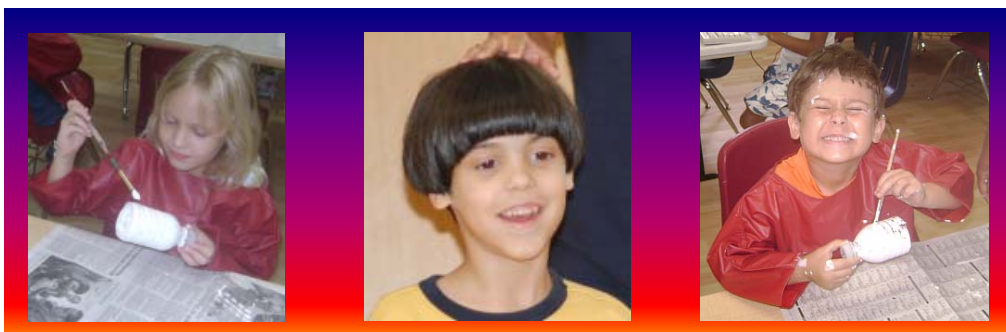
Group 1 – “School of Fish”

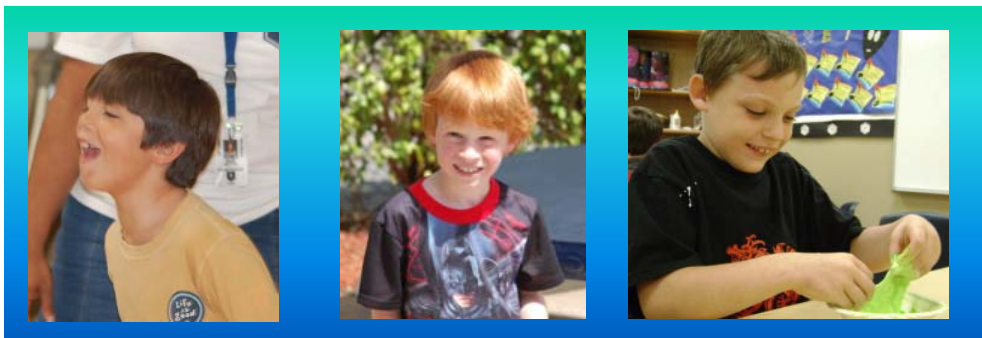
Group 3 – “The Rock Stars”
