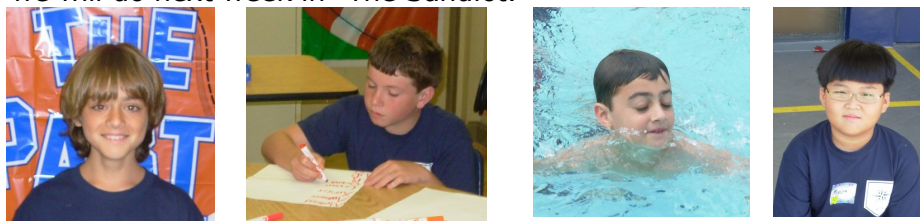
Room 2 – Week 1
