

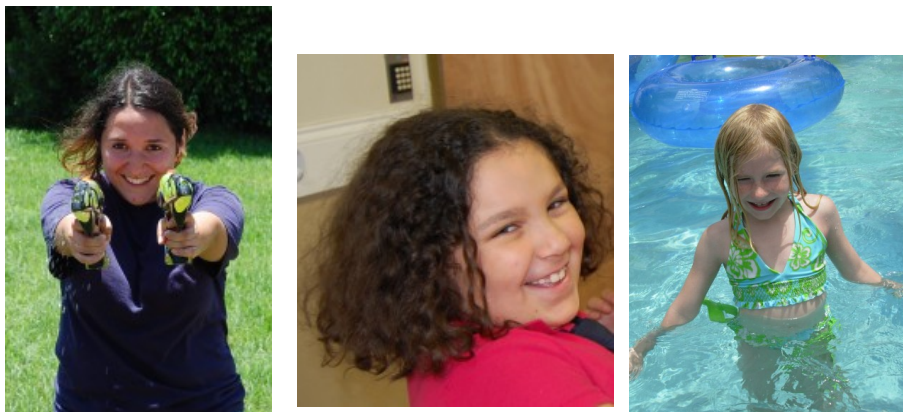
Room 1 – Week 4 “Pungu Island”

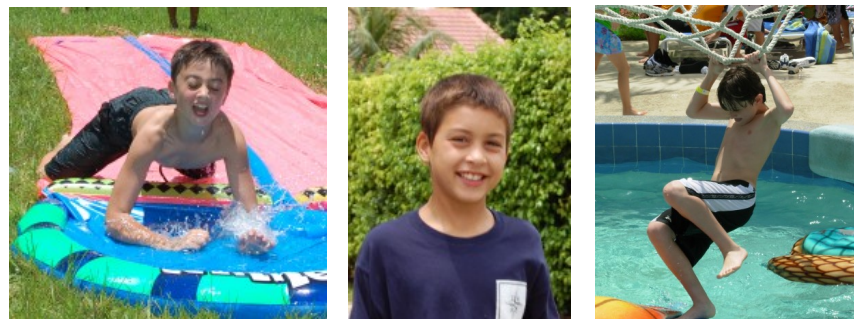
Room 2 – Week 4 “Superhero Training Center”
