

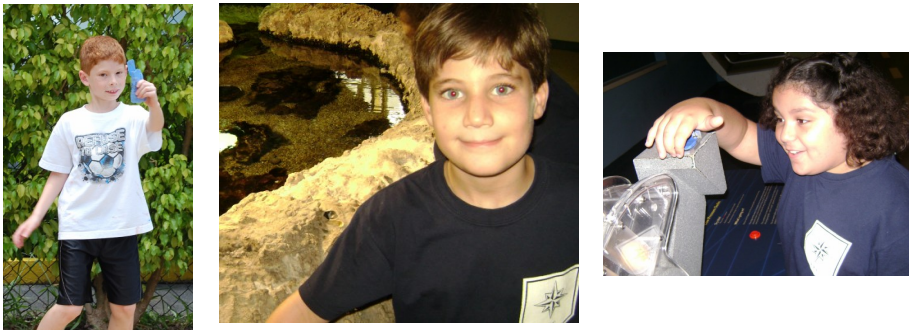
Room 1 – Week 7 “Pungu Island”
